Dali 17 Curator Hilary Roberts presented an in-depth program featuring the incredible works of this renowned artist, Salvador Dali. While living in the Monterey Peninsula during the 1940s, Dali was heavily involved in the social art scene. Along with images of the artist's strikingly creative works, Hilary showed vintage photographs of Dali's costumed events and notorious parties, including one held at the Del Monte Hotel in 1941 attended by Bob Hope, Gloria Vanderbilt and other celebrities. The Dali 17 Museum (formerly Art Museum of Monterey) holds a permanent exhibition of remarkable and unprecedented art, including original etchings, mixed media, lithographs, and rare sculptures by one of the twentieth century's premier and most celebrated surrealist artists, Spaniard Salvador Dali. This is the first permanent Dali exhibition located on the West Coast and the largest private collection on exhibition in the United States. The presentation was followed with tea and refreshments.
