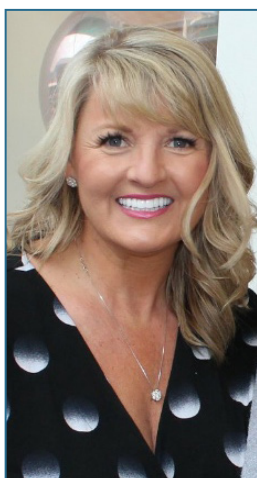
Hello Members,

Born in 1917 the day before America joined the Allies to fight the Germans in W.W.I. in San Francisco to a father who lives through the 1906 San Francisco earth quake and a mother whose parents died of pneumonia leaving 7 small children in Kentucky. At age 9 she came to California alone on the train to live with an Aunt and Uncle.

At age 18 she enrolled at Stanford-Lane Hospital as a nurse. There she met my father who was at the eye clinic studying to be an optometrist. They married at age 22 and 26. Along came my sister and four years later I arrived.

High school passed quickly – then my college years were filled with much activity in drama and dance. I earned my teachers’ credentials and on graduation I secured a position as a second-grade teacher. After one year I met and married

a wonderful young man who had gone to high school with me. We had almost sixty years of married life with three sons living in Stockton, California.

We moved to Carmel after my husband retired at 60. It was then I joined the Carmel Woman’s Club and soon became President. I joined 10 organizations, but stayed with CWC the longest.

I volunteered with the Symphony Auxiliary and taught art history and biography of famous people at the Carmel Foundation. I made many friends in those 14 years.

My husband died in 1999 and in 2004 I married again to my high school sweetheart after over sixty years had passed. We were both 85 and had 10 wonderful years travelling and enjoying life in our “golden” years. Charles Parsons passed away six years ago and I am still here at 102 - Enjoying good health and many friendships.

Roxann Jacobus did a wonderful job presenting the structures and stories of the amazing architect and the incredible philanthropist women who funded this project back in 1913.

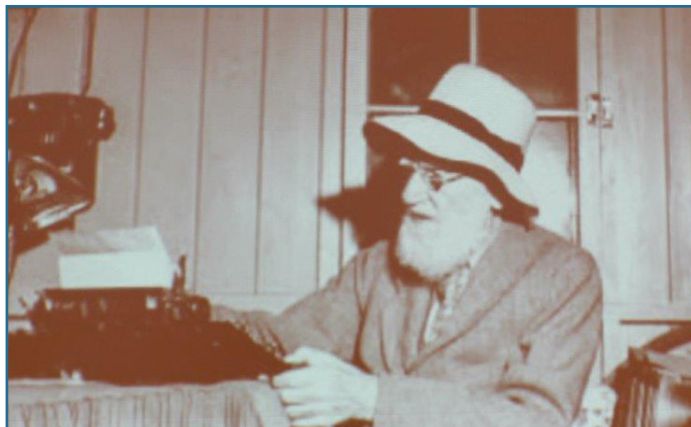


Oh Pshaw!
